



John McCallum asks, now that I've read the rulebook, will I revise the Wild 'n Wooly decision to award the game only to the player who has gained control of a total of 18 supply centers to a ruling more comparable to the rulebook's "majority of units" rule. The answer is no. After a game has gone on for two or more years, what is the harm in going on for another month or so to require the winner to "prove" his win? Theoretically, it is possible for a player to gain a majority of units and be in such an awkward position that the other players can still put him out of the game.

JUNGLE

A player, (name withheld to protect the guilty), has suggested a game which might be good practice for Diplomacy. It is certainly faster. Seven or more players write their orders on little slips of paper (no game board is used). On each turn, each player may attack one player (by name) or defend from two players (by name). You may never attack and defend at the same time. When a player is attacked by someone that he is not defending from on that turn, he is eliminated. (When two players attack each other, they are both eliminated). When there are only 3 players left, you may defend from only one player. The game could often end in a draw, but it will surely make enemies and destroy friendships much faster than Diplomacy.
