(Berlin) It was announced today that the previous instability of the German government was merely a contrived front to buy time for honing our dreaded saber thrust into Europe's Breadbasket. In Pomp, in Pageantry, in Wagnerian grandeur, in mass demonstrations that create mass Emotion we will Defeat Democracy with the tools of democracy:

I discern the closeness of civilized man with the savagery of animals, and fathom only reason to separate the two. Reason can treacherously deceive a man, but Emotion is sure and never leaves him.

Nothing is more certainly written in the book of fate than that Diplomacy Fans are to be free; nor is it less certain that these Fans, equally free, cannot live in the same Fandom. (Rome) Government ministers reported to the Senate that negotiations are taking place with the various claimants to the British Throne, and all factions have declared that the major British Throne, and all factions have declared that the major goal is to restore order to the Island Kingdom, and to bring the Fleets under some kind of central government. While these negotiations are taking place, Roman Fleets are protecting the British Isles from invasion. It is expected that the government will not ask for permission to incorporate Britain into the Roman Empire for some time to come. One minister is quoted as having said, "After all, so long as the British Fleets stand gaurd over the northern approaches to our French territory, why replace them? It would take over a year, for example, to bring another fleet up to do the job which the British North Sea force is doing now --, namely, bottling up the German Fleet. However, the Channel is very important for our future invasion plans, and we find it necessary, when the British sailors will not join our Roman Navy, to retire the English Channel Fleet." (St. Petersburg) For the first time in four years, reporters have managed to locate the government, although the Foreign Office is still missing. A mimeographed sheet was distributed which extolled the Heroic Fighting of the German (sic) armed forces, deplored all bloodshed, and, as an after thought, declared war on England and Turkey. Several spaces were left blank, to be filled in at a later date, if such should be required, and someone had scratched Italy's name on the list.
