(Rome) Her Royal Majesty, Queen E. Barbara Phillip, spoke to her people from St. Peter's Basilica.

"It is a particularly sad duty which causes me to come before you, My People, today. There is a clear and present danger to our national and to world peace that is manifesting itself in the form of an Arms Race on this continent.

I must notify you, regretfully however, that certain governmental controls must be imposed in the interest of national defense. His Holiness, Pope Paul VII, formerly a Professor of Economics at MIT, will guide our nation Spiritually, and the following statesmen will form a new Cabinet:

Minister of Economics;	Fritz Machup
Minister of State;	Milton Friedman
Minister of Peace;	Gottfried Warberler
Minister of Defense;	Abba Ferner
Minister of the Interior;	George Stigler
Minister of Agriculture;	Theodore Schultz
Minister of Labor;	Jacob Viner

- b) A 10% rebate on all Capital Expenditures.
- c) A bonus for each Pizza Pie or can of Spaghetti & meat balls exported to the hungry masses of the U.S.A.

Under the rulebook, this game would be over now, but Wild 'n Wooly requires the winner to control 18 supply centers, so consequently, every game will end with a Fall move.

Too many of you people spend thousands of dollars on the Telephone Company. A local "friend" of mine came up with an easy way to send a limited message by telephone without spending any money. Best of all, each two players can have their own personal code. List all of the provinces and sea areas in some sort of order and match them up to the names on your N3F roster (after eliminating those people with duplicate first or last names). The person's first name will be used for where the unit is and their last name will indicate where it is going to. Then call person to person, asking for this composite name at your ally's phone number. He'll refuse the call, saving any charges, and still know the move.

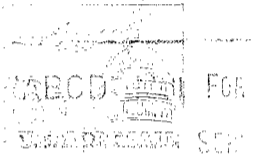
