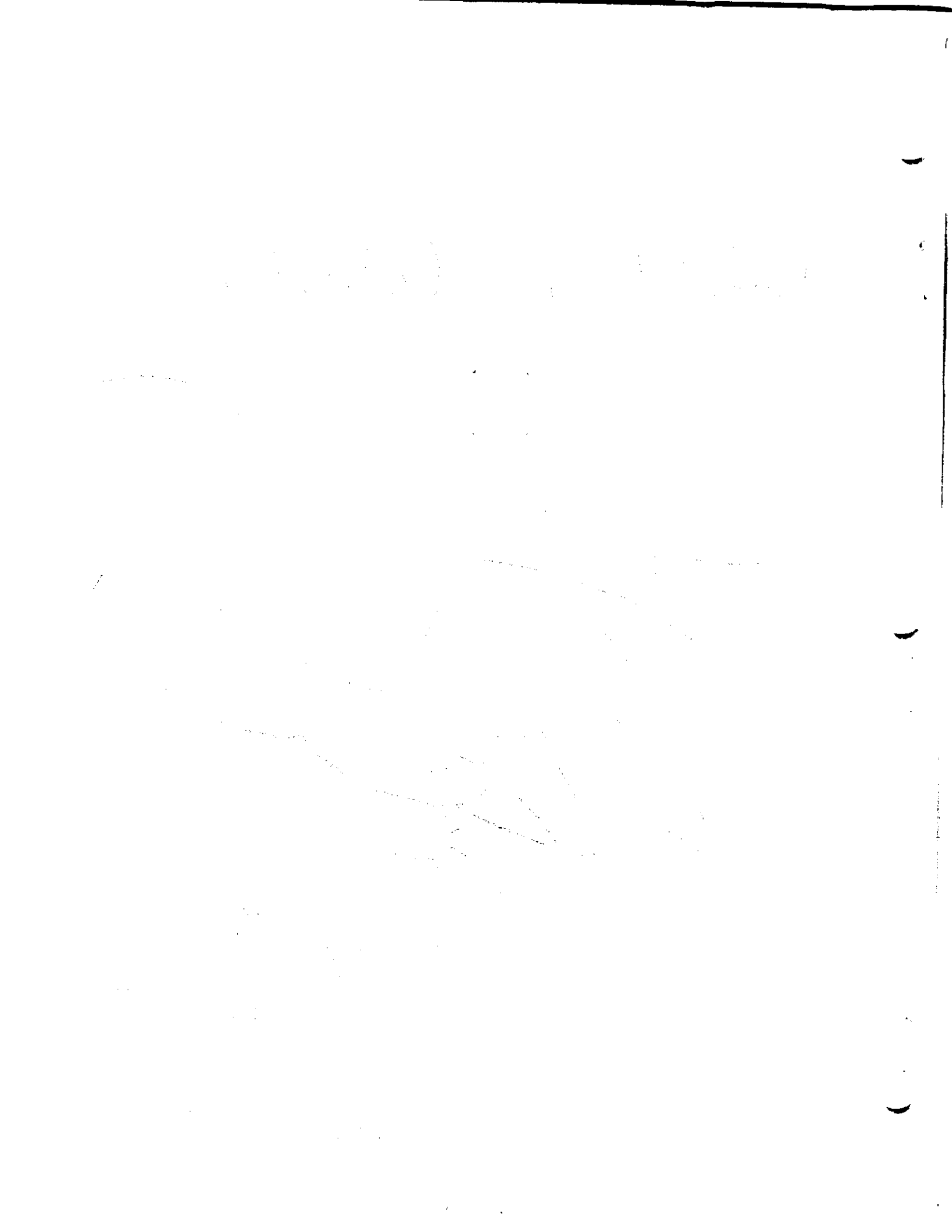

ITALY MOVED ARMY TRIESTE TO VENICE and builds only two. (I've got to quit eating those little wooden blocks!) (Did you ever notice how the Go - stones look like mints?)

(Transalpine Gaul, Hdqtrs. Magnus Soldat, Counsol of Rome, Comm. in Cheif of Roman Armies, Gaul) The recent victories of Roman arms in Iberia have provided the treasure to train and outfit an additional 30 Legions. The new army will re-inforce the Council's command and enable him to win new and even greater victories over the barbarian hordes of Ward the Terrible.

From the Flagship of Admiral Aqua, rumours are spreading that the fleets have been ordered to free the Britons from the clutches of the Odious Edipus. In any event, the Admiral has ordered units from as far away as North Africa to prepare for sea duty.

(Rome) Six-penicus announced today that peace has been negotiated with the Germanic Viennesse. To secure the eastern borders and the provinces of Asia Minor; Macedonia had to be conceded to Konicus.

(Berlin) The Imperial Government announced that it could no longer tolerate Italian forces on German soil. He said that it was his hope that War could be avoided, with Italy, and negotiations resumed, but after receipt of an Italian Ultimatum refusing even to consult with the German government, the Army was ordered to act. "As for Russia!" he said, "It is unfortunate that the National Security compels us to act to make safe our borders. We do presume that Russia will declare War."
