(Berlin) The Imperial Chancery announced today that five Divisions of Jaegers Supported by a Spearhead of Prussian Cavalry entered the Russian Capitol of St. Petersburg. Reports from the Russian front indicated that the Army entered in good order, but that units of Imperial Marines supporting the operation were forced to fire on armed civilians who attempted to block their entry into the naval base on the island of Kronstad. Russian marine and fleet units resisting the German forces inflicted severe-casualties on Marine units from the Barents Sea fleet. Meanwhile, the North Sea Fleet which has been continuously at sea for two years now, was ordered to Denmark for leaves and replacements.

Kaiser Wilhelm, in a speech from the Throne, once again emphasized that it was not too late for Italy to surrender its forces in Prussia and conclude an Honourable Peace with the Reich. If they do not, he warned, Germany will send sufficient force to wipe out these upstart Romans to the man. In obvious reference to reports from Paris, the Kaiser stated that he had not received a Declaration of War from any power, but that the Empire assumed that the Russians considered themselves to be at war with us. He noted that the borders with France were undefended, and that it seemed unlikely that the French were serious in their latest threats, considering the immense power of the German Armies.

The new zine will be better and possibly bigger. It has not been named as yet. I'll be the Assistant Gamesmaster in all the games except those that I'm playing in. The new magazine will also carry the Beginners game for which we are finally getting players.

THE BEGINNERS GAME This will be a game for players new to postal Diplomacy. Tell your friends about it.

AND NOW WE HAVE "SWENSON'S RULE" !! Those of us unfortunate enough to read "MESKATONIC UNIVERSITY" (more properly known as "Swenson's Folly") have found therein a new rule even worse than Miller's infamous "Rule 9".

Swenson, who apparently has no use for heroes, has published a rule applicable to Postal Diplomacy games in his "MISKATONIC UNIVERSTY" (see page 4 for address) which penalizes any lone units which must fight in more than one direction.

"Swenson's Rule" requires that a unit which attempts to move relinquishes all rights to the province from which it is trying to move from. This allows any other single unsupported unit to enter that province.

Further, "Swenson's Rule" demands that if this single unit is stood off where it is attempting to move to and another unit captures its beginning point, the single unit's attack as well is voided. The opposing unit that stood it off takes the province that the single unit attacked and the enemy unit requires no support. The single unit is thus unsuccessful in both places and the opposing units occupy both provinces.

BUT THAT'S NOT ALL !! OH, NOT ENOUGH FOR THE DIABOLICAL SWENSON!! "Swenson's Rule" also does not even allow the single unit to retreat! It is removed from the board for even daring to try to defend itself.

We now have TITLE CARDS for each Supply Centre for the local games. Those of you who play Monopoly know what a Title Card is.

Wild 'n Wooly may publish some more games, after all. Those of you who have games paid for in Wild 'n Wooly may demand that your games be in Wild 'n Wooly instead of the new magazine.

All games paid for prior to Aug. 1, 1966 will be traded game for game with games paid for by Wild 'n Wooly in the new magazine. In other words, you will have the same number of games paid for in the new magazine that you had in Wild 'n Wooly. You will each be notified individually of the number of games that you have credited to your account in the new magazine.

The rules in Wild 'n Wooly will stay the same but the rules in the new magazine where I am only the Assistant Gamesmaster will likely be somewhat more like the standardized rules of many other magazines.

As some of Wild 'n Wooly's games draw to a close, Wild 'n Wooly will publish the Map and Rules for Tomahawk. And also, possibly, Armageddon.

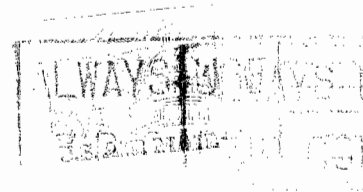
