

(London) His Majesty's government wishes to announce that; as per terms of our Treaty with the Republic of France, and due to the hostile actions of certain enemy forces, that a State of War now exists between the United Kingdom and the Empire of Austria-Hungary.

(Vienna) Further failure of the English to respond and agree to suitable lines of demarcation and spheres of influence in the East will inevitably force Austria-Hungary to claim and establish forward positions to protect our people from the English.

1965KN

(Paris) King John II addressed Parliment today for the first time in two years. It was felt that the recent addition of a fleet had ameliorated the Deputies anger at least to the point where his lives were not in danger. However, some Deputies from the Radical Socialist Alliance Party did throw old vegetables.

The King announced a Daring New Northern Offensive, prompting some Deputies to ask for a "Daring New Southern Offensive" to free areas of metropolitan Spain and Marseilles.
