

CLAUDIANA (Ides of January MCHXI AD) Battle-scarred veterans of the Roman Imperial Legions ran in terror as an animated corpse arose from the sepulchural vaults of the former Austrian Emperors. We have two new proposed rules:

- An army, attempting to move, and stood off may be Supported in its starting point.
- An army or fleet may Support any unoccupied land province (to which it could otherwise attempt to move to) for its current ownership without the existence of a unit to be supported. Thus, a unit could hold its ground and defend an adjacent province without attempting to move there.
