(Paris) The French Foreign Ministry today announced the terms of the proposed French stalemate. "The Franco-German alliance will hold the line from St. Petersburg to Tunis indefinitely, a total of seventeen supply depots." was the official comment. The French Deputy Foreign Minister challenged refutation of this claim by the enemy powers.

(Berlin) The Imperial Chancery announced a strong counter offensive in conjunction with French support, to retake Munich. At this time it is not known whether or not the offensive succeeded, but the failure of the enemy to hold Silesia makes it possible that, with maximum French co-operation, Munich will once again be returned to the Crown. German Naval might will then make itself felt in the Baltic, and it is possible that, within the year, German soil will be cleared of foreign armies.
