(Rome) The Senate of Rome has granted the King of Denmark the right to remain on the Throne, provided that Denmark always remains a Friend of the Roman People. The Kingdom of Holland also has applied for the status of Mi Amicus Romani, but the Senate has not yet acted upon their application.

From his retirement Villa, Cincinattus thundered a protest against Russian troop movements in the North. When informed that there was no way in which Russia could take any part of the New Empire which the former dictator had so skillfully acquired, he quickly apologised to Russia.

The Cato faction still insists that Austria will attack the Empire, but, since all the Senators of the Cato faction with the exception of Cato himself are now in active service on the Northern front, there is no chance of his opinions affecting the Imperial Policy.


