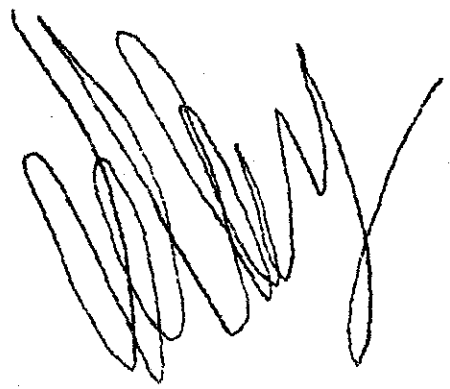
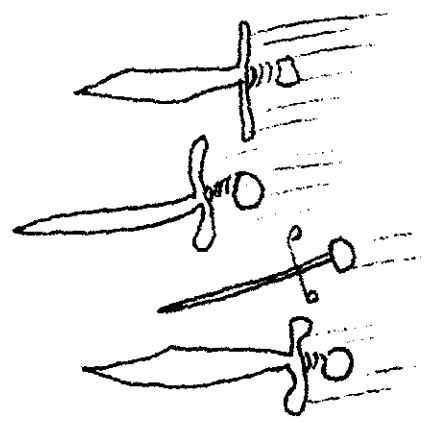

(Vienna) The rabble of the Empire gathered in the ruins of the Hungarian Victory Colosseum last fortnight to witness the operation of the world's largest wireless transmitter. Technicians said that this marvel of Austrian ingenuity uses a new technical breakthrough called the "spark-gap". (Vienna) After a Spring refitting and strategic withdrawal, the Austrian Grand Fleet returns to action in a series of manoeuvres off Italy & Greece. Early reports indicate the annihilation of one army and the confused retreat of the French Ionian Squadron now based at Naples.

On land, the Rome Garrison after fierce fighting, was able to enter the dock area at Naples but the Eastern armies are reported to be still carrying out strategic withdrawals and regroupings and have not yet returned to the Offensive.

(Rome) The Senate of Rome has granted the King of Denmark the right to remain on the Throne, provided that Denmark always remains a Friend of the Roman People. The Kingdom of Holland also has applied for the status of Mi Amicus Romani, but the Senate has not yet acted upon their application.

From his retirement Villa, Cincinattus thundered a protest against Russian troop movements in the North. When informed that there was no way in which Russia could take any part of the New Empire which the former dictator had so skillfully acquired, he quickly apologized to Russia.

The Cato faction still insists that Austria will attack the Empire, but, since all the Senators of the Cato faction with the exception of Cato himself are now in active service on the Northern front, there is no chance of his opinions affecting the Imperial Policy.

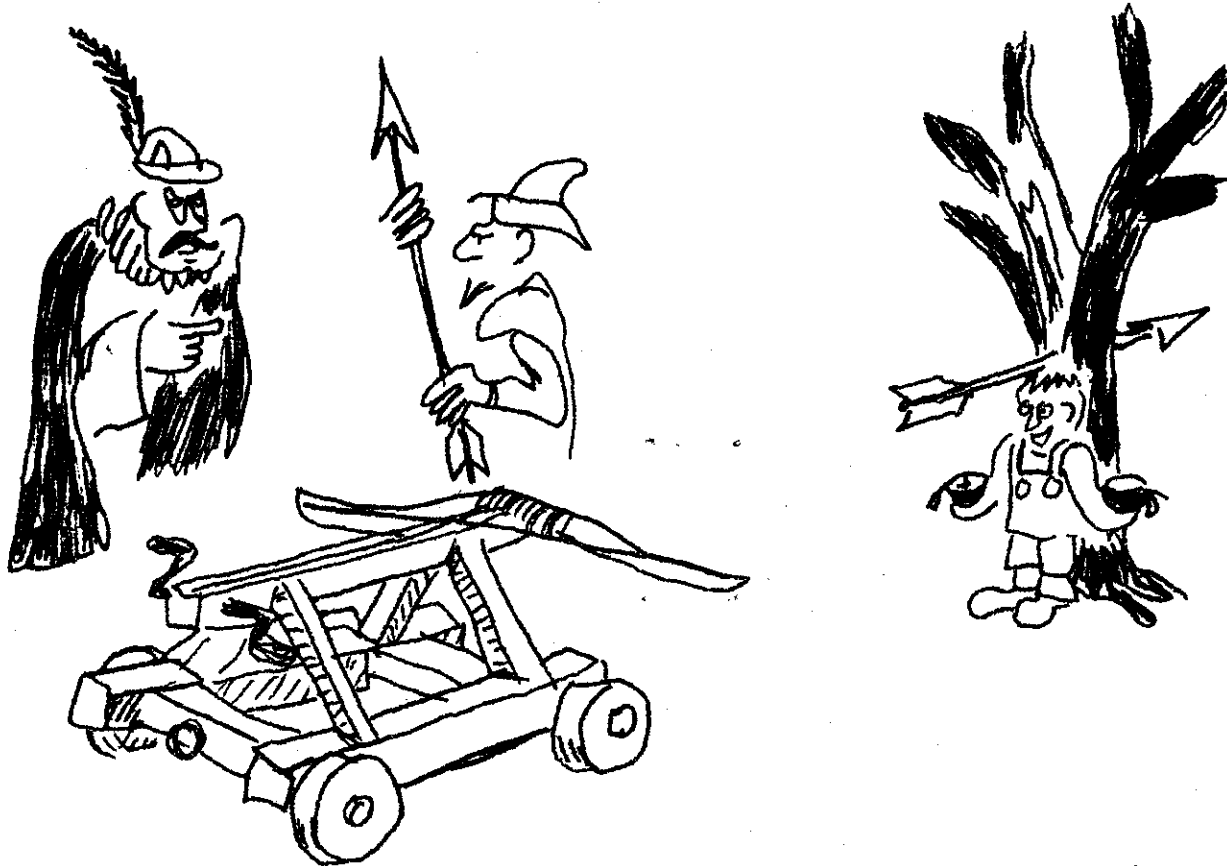
