### LUSITANIA SPLITS TWO - FOR - ONE ! ! !

LUSITANIA was one of California's finest publications. It did not appear too often which added greatly to its charm. LUSITANIA carried two games - Two nicely slow-paced very enjoyable games. Now one version of each game has been taken off Bernie's hands by Anders Svenson to be published in MISKATONIC UNIVERSITY AND WE WILL PUBLISH ANOTHER VERSION OF EACH GAME IN WILD 'N WOOLY.

The MISKATONIC UNIVERSITY versions of each game will pick up where Bernie Kling left off. The WILD 'N WOOLY versions of each game will go back to Spring 1901, by special request of Charles N. Reinsel.

Why does Bernie Kling no longer publish LUSITANIA??? Bernie had many publishing problems; a rigorous High School, poor pubbing with poor equipment, parental disapproval, lack of postage (he only charged \$1 each), etc., but even so, the LUSITANIA games might still be published and gamemastered by Bernie Kling if it were not for the Inquisitor.

By constantly badgering, and sometimes even slandering, John Boardman, Ph.D. (who has no trouble publishing because of the cheap materials he uses) has finally forced Bernie to give up altogether. Since the whole LUSITANIA takeover has been planned and pushed on us by John Boardman, Ph.D.; the full responsibility for playing all of the positions rests with John Boardman, Ph.D. He doesn't need to volunteer for any of the positions because he already has, for all practical purposes, indicated an insane desire to play all of the positions. He even published an issue or two of LUSITANIA himself, without Bernie's permission, in an effort to get the games speeded up.

Well, John Boardman, Ph.D. has got what he wanted. LUSITANIA has been taken over and all of the positions are his. However, since it would not be much fun for him to play all by himself, many of the original players are willing to stay in and show him a good time, such as he really deserves, after all the hard work he has put into this.

LUSITANIA game One is now WILD 'N WOOLY game 1967KX It is a 5 man game with the Barents Sea, St. Petersburg, Finland, the Gulf of Bothnia, Livonia, Prussia, Warsaw, Galicia, Rumania, Bulgaria, the Aegean Sea, and the Eastern Mediterranean and everything East of them out of the game. This leaves 25 supply centers and lowers the requirement for winning to 13 supply centers or a majority of the units.

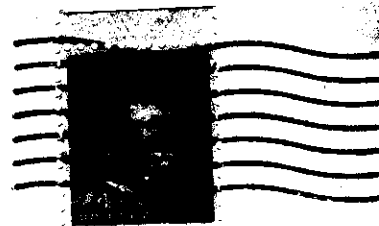
