(Berlin) The Chancellor announced that due to the requests of the Bundesrat, all military furloughs heretofore postponed will be allowed to all troops with very few exceptions. Certain men of the Geheimrat have been heard to say that this has more to do with increasing the attractiveness of the Army, rather than the expression of any desire to please the upper chamber.
