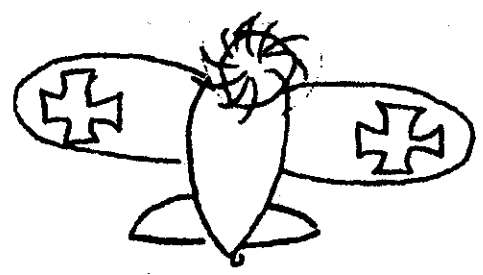
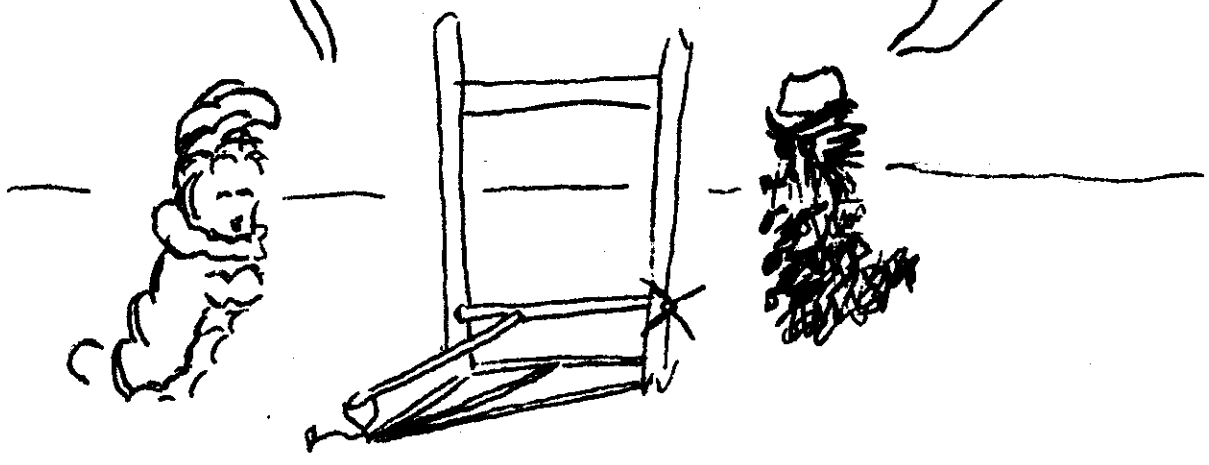

(Rome) At the application of the Stuart Dynasty, Italian Special Forces were ordered to Edinburgh to quell a rebellion of Hanover Loyalists. Under the terms of the Treaty of Restoration, the Stuarts are not allowed any land or naval forces of their own.

The third Fleet entered the Baltic Sea to conduct scientific investigations and map the contours of the sea bottom. Unfortunately, rioting broke out in Kiel and the First Army in the Netherlands had to restore order with force.

The new 9th Legionary Army, officered by recent graduates of the Imperial Academy, was dispatched to the Near East in a surprise move. The Senate was in confusion and demanded an explanation from the Government, but so far the only word is that the Legionaries will be concerned with the consolidations of the British possessions in that area. It was noted that there is little likelihood of any incident partly because of the high family connections of the officers. At least, one Senator told the press that he believes the new Legion will take off the monotonous support duties from the Fourth Fleet.
