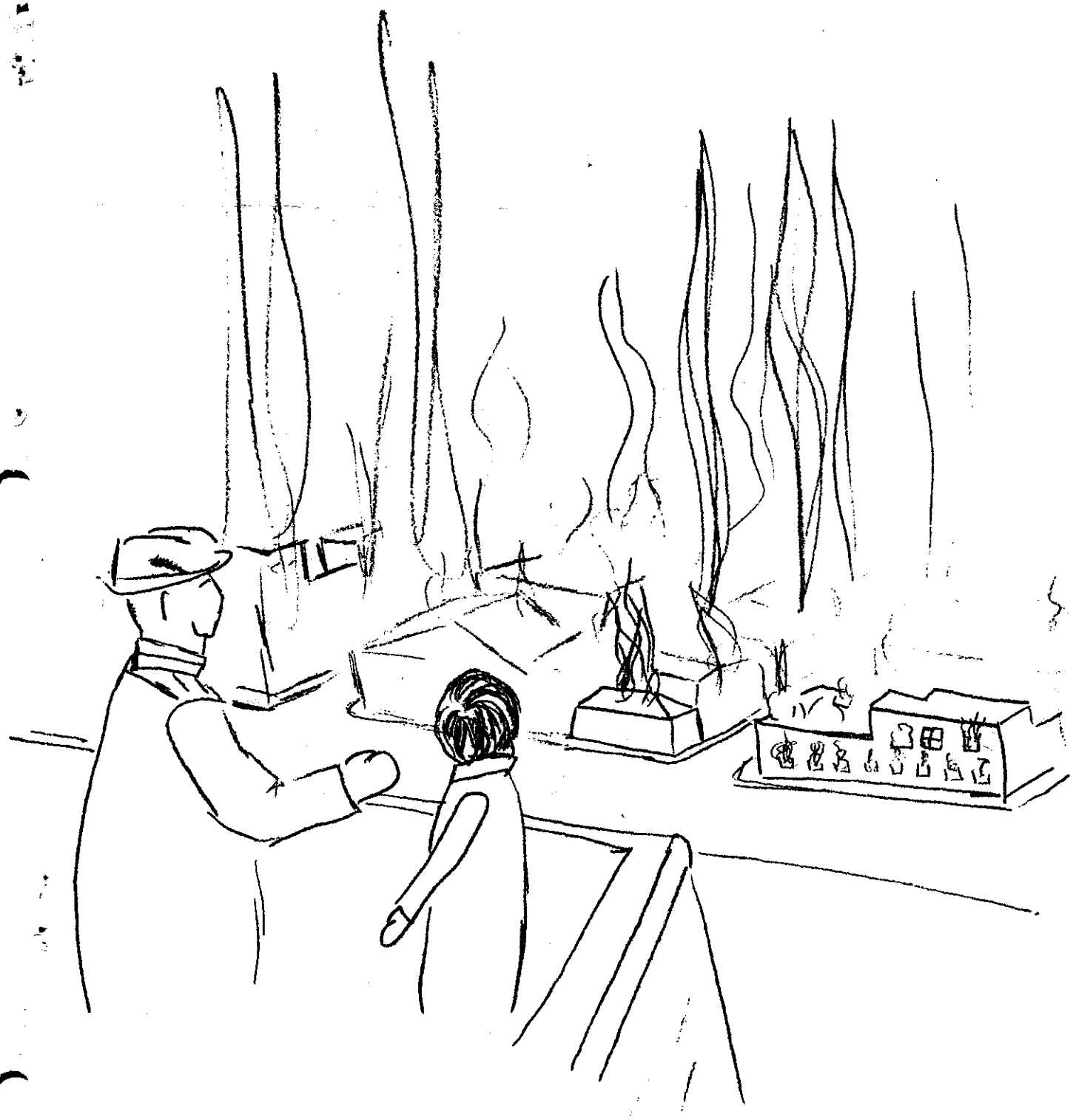

(Rome) An unexpected and unexplained request from the Austrian High Command demanding that the Army of Tyrolain Alps embark immediately into Bohemia left the King completely unable to understand the situation. Although the Gate faction denounced the request as a thin pretext to inveigle Italy into a war with Austria or Russia, his Majesty ordered the Praetorian Prefect to draft and transmit the orders.

"We have no war with Austrians and they want none with us", His Majesty announced.

WILD 'N WOOLY GOES ECONOMIC!! In every game wherein all the players in the game indicate a desire to have the game converted to Economic Diplomacy; the following rule shall apply:

Economic rule. At the end of each Fall move, the bank pays each player one chip for each supply center under his Control. The player must pay the bank one chip for each unit he keeps on the board and one chip for each unit he builds. (You may not build and remove units in the same game-year). Each player may have more or less units than supply centers as he chooses so long as he has chips to maintain them with. (The Victory Criterion is still 18 supply centers)

Foreign Trade: For each 2 chips received from another player, the bank will pay you one chip (but only on the Spring and Fall moves)
