(Rome) Cincinattus has retired to his country villa, and the Roman people are still celebrating their victory.

His last statement before retiring from public life was characteristically ~~brief~~ wordy. Il Duce said simply, "Without the exemplary good faith on the part of the Austrians, our Victory would not have been possible. We only wish that all allies were as faithful, and all enemies as honorable, as the Austrians and Russians have been!"

His Majesty was preparing to receive the surrender message from the Tsar of All the Russias. When questioned, he had nothing but praise for the Russians, whom he described as honest in their agreements and ferocious in their battles. His Majesty also praised the Austrians, and stated categorically that there have been few alliances as faithfully kept as the Austrians have kept their pact.

(Vienna) Johannes Wolfgangus, erudite, debonair, free-flowing Emperor of Austria and Lion of Judah, announced this morning the final end of the long, bitter, bloody war which has ravaged the continent for twelve years. The Emperor pledged to re-establish Austrian dominions in Bohemia and the Tyrol, to retake Galicia, and eventually to incorporate Roumania and the rest of the Old Ottoman Empire into his realm.

"Otherwise, the continent belongs to whichever power wants it," bleated the Emperor. "It is our hope that the now apologetic Russians may be given a chance to do better. If they can show civil progress and drive the foul Snowmen out of Russia for good, we'll give Poland back to them."
