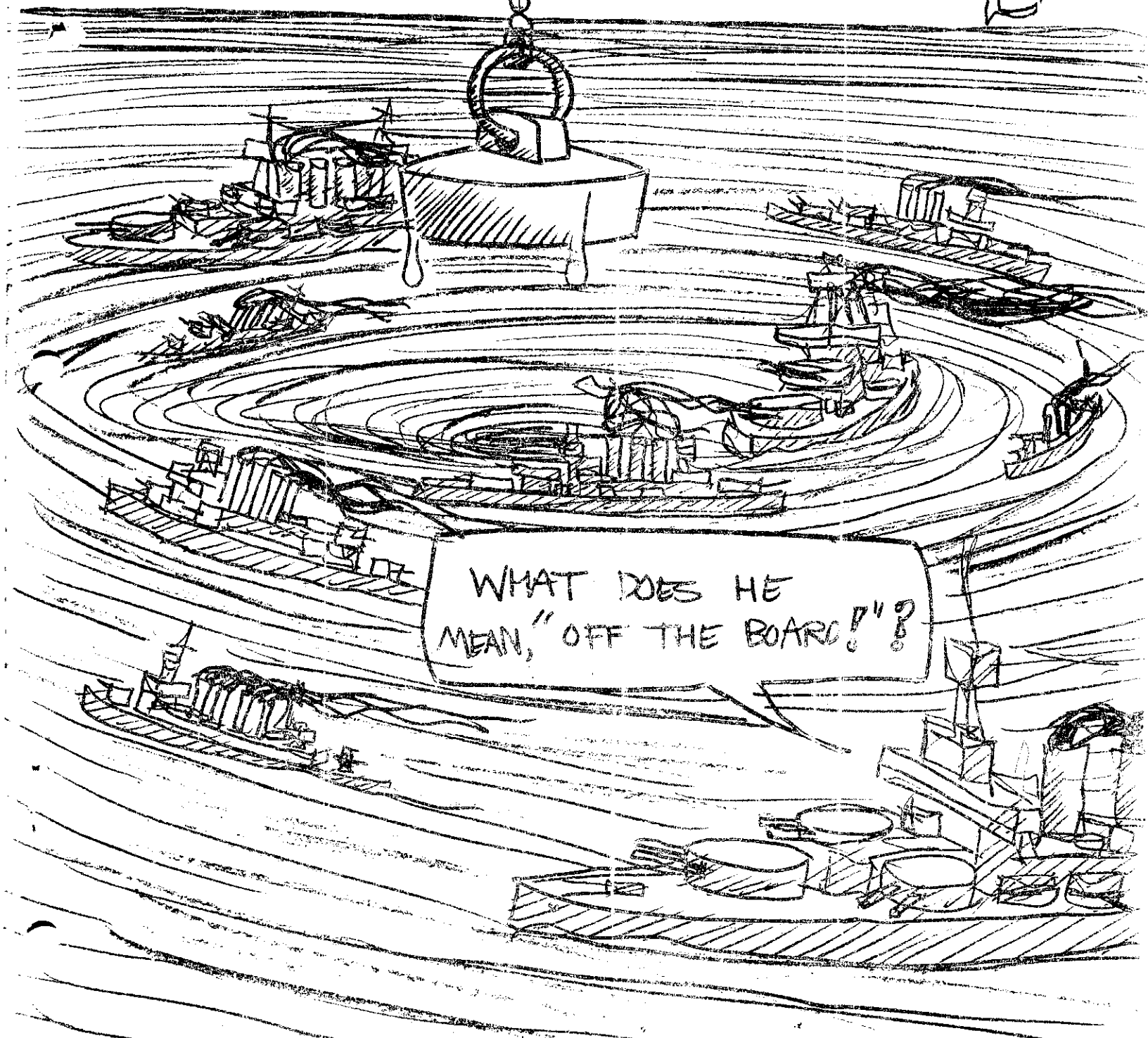


# Wild 'n Woolly

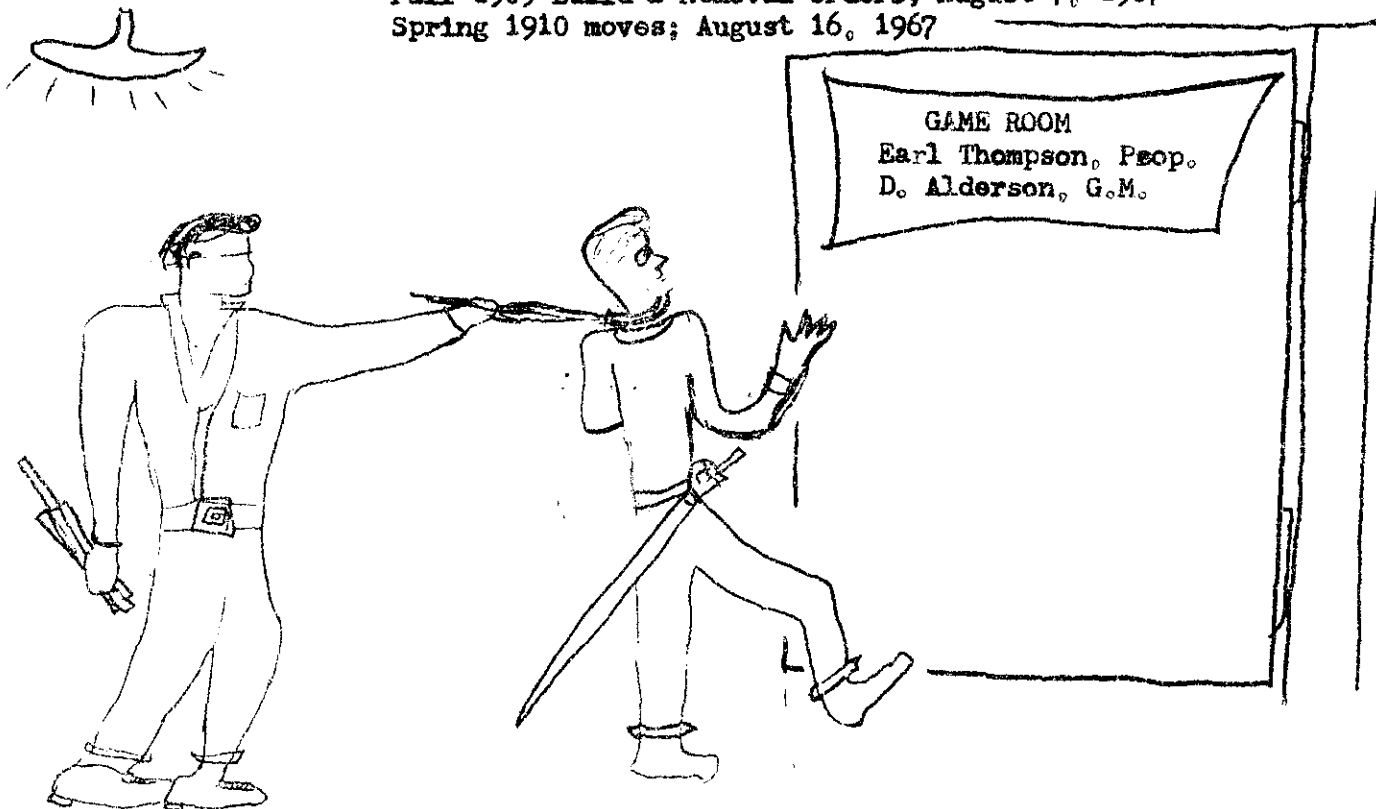
