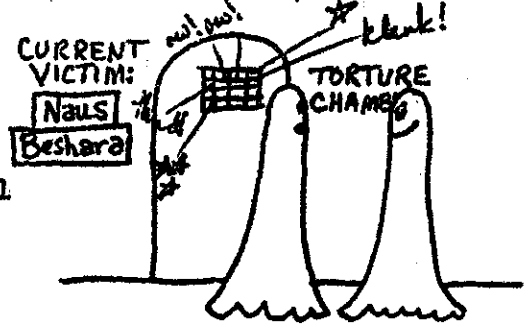

BOTH GAMES: The "tentative" and "final" move system will be used for both games. "Tentative" moves become "final" on the deadline. "Final" moves may be changed at any time, provided adjudication has not taken place. Moves not labeled "tentative" or "final" will be regarded as "final". The moment I have a full set of "final" moves for any game, I will adjudicate.

ENGLAND (McCallum): A Lva H, F Eng-Mid, F Wes-Tyr, A Wal H, A War H, F Mid-Wes, A Mos S A Sev, A Rum MS A Bud, A Gal, A Ukr, & A Sev S A Rum. Owns: Edi, Lpl, Lon, Den, Nwy, Swe, StP, Mos, War, Bud, Sev, Rum (12). No change.

FRANCE (Wells): A Gas-Bur S by A Mar, A Pio, & A Par, F Tri H S by F Alb & F Adr, F Lyo-Pie, A Pie-Tyr S by A Ven. Owns: Bre, Mar, Par, Spa, Por, Nap, Rom, Ven, Tun, Tri (10). No change.

GERMANY (Naus): A Bur H S by A Ruh, A Bel, & A Mun, A Tyr H S by A Vie. Owns: Ber, Kie, Mun, Hol, Vie, Bel (6). No change.

TURKEY (Koning): A Gre S A Ser, F Aeg-Ion, F Arm-Sev, F Bla-Con, A Bul-Rum S by A Ser. Owns: Ank, Con, Smy, Bul, Gre, Ser (6). No change.

SPRING 1918 MOVES are due Monday, 25 January 1971. This is the second consecutive year in which no supply center has changed hands. Under the provisions of House-Rule 17, if this situation persists another game-year, the game is a draw.

ENGLAND (Koning): A Den-Kie S by F Bel, F Hth-Eng S by F Wal, F Lon, & F Iri, F Nat-Mid, A Pru-Ber, A War-Mos, F Hol-Hol. Owns: Edi, Lpl, Lon, Den, Nwy, Swe, War, StP, ~~Mad~~, ~~Par~~, Mos, Kie (10). No change (1/a/).

FRANCE (Kuch): A Kie-Ber S by A Sil & A Mun, A Hol H S by F Bel, F Spa(so)-Mid S by F Wes, A Pio-Bur, F Eng H S by F Bro (F Eng /d//Pio, ob/). Owns: Bre, Mar, Par, ~~Kie~~, Spa, Tun, Bel, Por, Hol, Mun, Ber (10). No change.

RUSSIA (Naus): A Ukr H, A Gal H /d//Bob, ob/. Owns: ~~Par~~, ~~Mad~~ (0). Remove 2.

TURKEY (vonMetzke): A Sev-Mos, A Arm-Sev S by F Bla, A Ser-Bud S by A Vie, A Ser-Bud S by A Vie (hmm...he only did that once, actually), F Cen-Aeg, F Alb-Ion, F Aeg-Eas, F Ven-Adr, A Bud-Gal S by A Rum. Owns: Ank, Con, Smy, Nap, Rom, Tri, Bul, Gre, Ven, Ser, Vie, Bud, Rum, Sev (14). Build 3.

WINTER 1913 and SPRING 1914 orders are due on Monday, 25 January 1971. These may be made conditional upon the Turkish builds if you wish. If France decides to remove the retreating unit and build in Paris or Marseilles, I will notify you-all.
