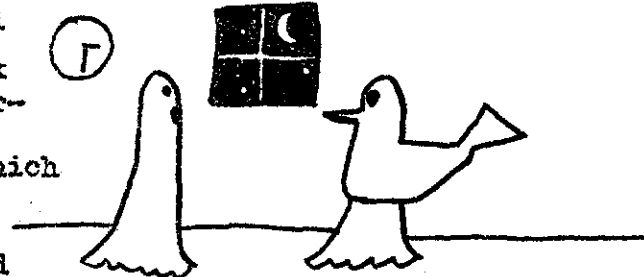


WYLLE & WORRIE 16
