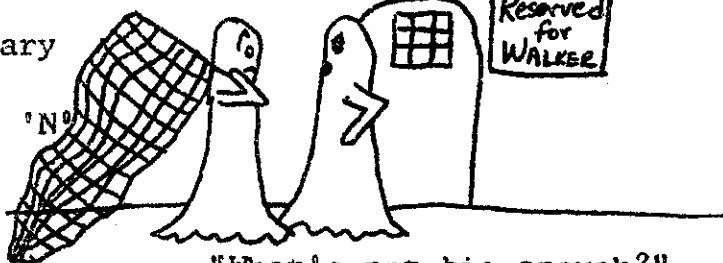

House-Rule 7 has been changed. The effect is that I will not call twice in a row for moves. However, because of the special status of these games, I doubt if I will apply the revised rule in this instance.

1966C -- TWO UNITS MOVE. TWO SUPPLY CENTERS CHANGE HANDS. wow...

Fall 1918: The Turkish unit in Armenia is an army, not a fleet. This error was not reported immediately, and has been allowed to persist for some time. However, in the interim, the unit has not moved as a fleet (i.e., "F" Arm-Bla), so there is no harm in correcting the error at this point.

ENGLAND (McCallum): A Lva-Mos, F NAF H, F Nap-Aru, A Yor H, A War H, F Wes-Tyr, A Mos-Sev S by A Ukr, A Rum MS A Bud, A Gal S A Rum, A Sev-Arm. Owns: Edi, Lpl, Lon, ~~Den~~, Nwy, Swe, StP, Mos, War, Bud, Sev, Rum, Nap (12). No change.

FRANCE (Wells): A Mar-Pie, A Pic-Bel S by A Bur, A Par S A Bur, F Tri-Ukr, F Adr-Aru, F Lyo-Mar, A Pie-Ven, A Ven-Tri S by F Alb. Owns: Bre, Mar, Par, Spa, Por, ~~Mid~~, Rom, Ven, Tun, Tri (9). Remove 1.

GERMANY (Naus): A Mun S A Ruh, A Bel H S by A Ruh, A Kie-Den, A Tyr H S by A Vie. Owns: Ber, Kie, Mun, Hol, Vie, Bel, Den (7). Build 1.

TURKEY (Koning): A Gre S A Ser, F Ion-Tyr, A Arm-Sev, F Aeg-Ion, A Bul-Rum S by A Ser. Owns: Ank, Con, Smy, Bul, Gre, Ser (6). No change.

SPRING 1919 MOVES are due on Tuesday, 16 March 1971. Charles Wells, please send your removal now and I'll send Winter 1918 out by carbon copy. If you don't get Winter 1918, please make conditional Spring 1919 moves, if you wish.

1966Z -- TURKS NEAR VICTORY

Fall 1914: Two French moves were misreported; instead of A Mun MS A Sil, they were A Mun & A Sil S A Ber. Positions were correct, but if the MS move had been right, England would be in Berlin. I informed John Koning of this over two weeks ago, and asked for corrected orders--and nothing. I am using his original set as General Orders so there will be English moves.

ENGLAND (Koning): F Hel S A Hol, F Eng-Bel S by A Hol, F Wal-Eng S by F Iri, F Lon-Nth, F Nat-Mid, A Pru-Sil S by A War (A War /d//Lva, ob/), F Bal-Kie. Owns: Edi, Lpl, Lon, Den, Nwy, Swe, ~~Wat~~, ~~StP~~, ~~Nos~~, Kie, Hol (8). Remove 2.

FRANCE (Kuch): A Ber H S by A Mun & A Sil, F Pic-Bel S by A Ruh, F Bel-Nth, F Mid H S by F Wes & F Bre. Owns: Bre, Mar, Par, Spa, Tun, Bel, Por, ~~Mid~~, Mun, Ber (9). No change (1 /a/).

TURKEY (vonMetzke): A Rum-Ukr, F Bla H, A Tri-Tyr, F Eas H, A Bul-Tri C by F Aeg, F Ion, & F Adr, A Mos-StP, A Sev-Mos, A Bud H, A Boh S FRENCH A Sil, A Ukr-War S by A Gal. Owns: as W13, Mos, StP, War (17). Build 3.

WINTER 1914 ADJUSTMENTS are due immediately, SPRING 1915 MOVES are due on Tuesday, 16 March 1971. Since there is no way to defend Norway, you-all may wish to concede to Turkey now. If so, let me know.
