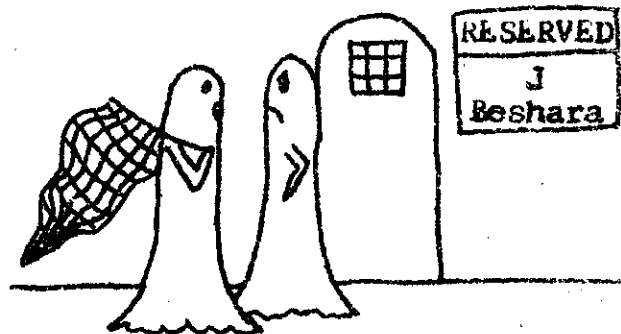

NEW GAME! Game W-1 is now open. The only requirement for joining is that you have to have won at least one postal game. I have intended to send out invitations to this, but have yet to do it. I will use this issue instead. Therefore:

IF YOU ARE THE WINNER OF A POSTAL DIPLOMACY GAME, and if you have received this, it is an invitation to join our First Winners' Game. Invitations are being sent only to those who are still regular and dependable players. The game fee is given above. The first seven winners who send a fee will be admitted to the game. Please send a list of the 7 Great Powers in the order of your preference. If there is sufficient interest, a second Winners' game will be opened, but I must ask each of you to join only one game. If you are about to win your first game, and it is demonstrably only a matter of time, you still qualify.

1966C -- CIVIL WAR IN TURKEY: NEITHER SULTAN SUBMITS ORDERS

Fall 1919: Since Conrad did not submit moves this time, and neither did John, I don't know who's Turkey. I'll give John one more chance before I remove him and will endeavor to get stand-by moves from Conrad. Otherwise I fear Turkey will go into civil disorder. France's moves are on the basis of General Orders given me by Charles over the 'phone last night.

ENGLAND (McCallum): A Lva-Mos, F Tun-Ion S by F Tyr & F Nap, A Yor H, A War H, A Mos-Sev, A Rum-Ser S by A Bud, A Sev-Rum S by A Ukr & A Gal. Owns: Edi, Lpl, Lon, Nwy, Swe, StP, Mos, War, Bud, Sev, Rum, Nap, Ser (13). Build 1.

FRANCE (Wells): A Pie-Tyr S by A Ven & A Tri, A Bur H S by A Pic & A Par, F Alb S A Tri, F Mar H, F Adr S A Tri. Owns: Bre, Mar, Par, Spa, Por, Rom, Ven, Tun, Tri (9). No change.

GERMANY (Naus): F Hol-Nth, A Mun S A Tyr, A Bel MS A Ruh, A Kie S A Mun, A Tyr MS A Vie. Owns: Ber, Kie, Mun, Hol, Vie, Bel, Den (7). N.c.

TURKEY (Koning??)(s/b vonMetzke?): NMR. A Gre, A Arm, F Aeg, A Bul /h/. F Ion /h/ /a/, A Ser /b/ /a/. Owns: Ank, Con, Smy, Bul, Gre, Ser (5). Build 1 (2 /a/).

WINTER 1919 BUILDS and SPRING 1920 MOVES are due on Wednesday, 28 April 1971. Spring 1920 will be delayed upon the specific request of any player. You may make your moves conditional upon (a) the builds and (b) the identity of the Turkish player.
