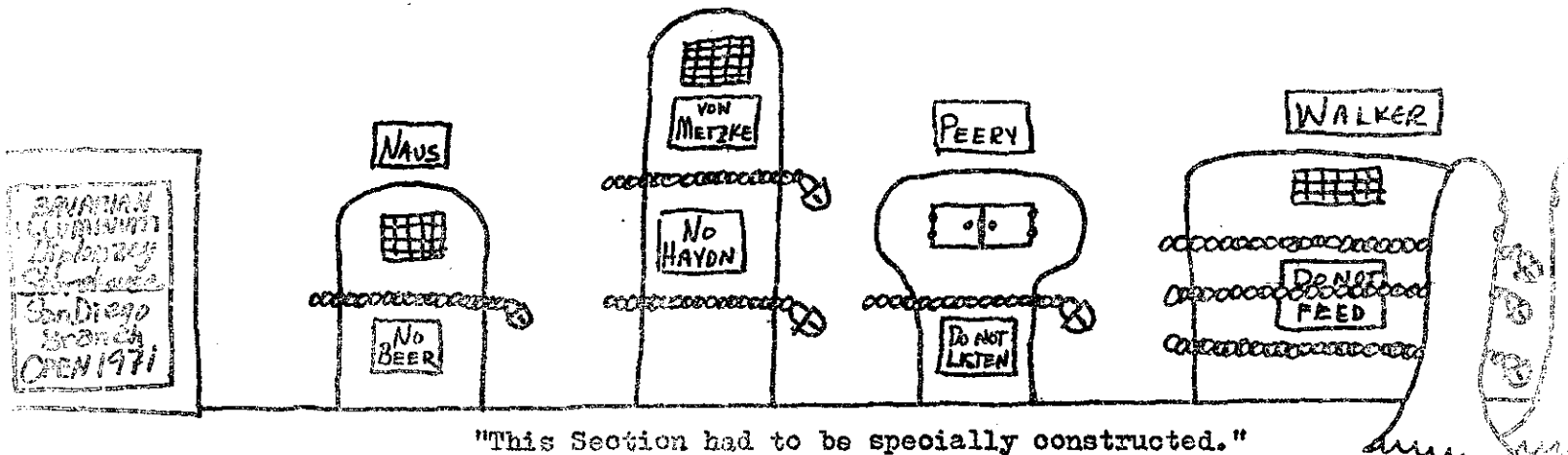


Wile 'n' Worry #2 5 May 1970

POWERS TEND TO EQUALIZE, BUT ENGLAND MORE EQUAL THAN OTHERS

Fall 1913:

ENGLAND (McCallum): F Lon H, F Nth H, F Bal H, A Lva-War, A Ukr-Run, A War-Ukr S by A Mos, A Boh-Gal, A Vie-Bud. Ows: Edi, Lpl, Lon, Den, Nwy, Swe, StP, Mos, War, Vie (10). Build 1.

FRANCE (Wells): F Lyo-Tyr, F Tun-Ion S by F Alb, F Gre-Aeg, A Par-Bar S by A Pic, A Gas-Har, A Pie-Tus, A Rom-Nap, A Bur-Mun. Ows: Bre, Mar, Par, ~~Bel~~, Spa, Por, Nap, Rom, ~~Yls~~, Tun, Gre (9). Remove 1.

GERMANY (Naus): A Bel H S by A Hol, A Ruh-Mun, A Tyr S A Tri, A Ven H, A Tri S ENGLISH A Vie-Bud. Ows: Ber, Kie, Mun, Hol, Tri, ~~Yls~~, Bel, Ven (7). Build 1.

TURKEY (Koning): F Bla S A Sev, F Con-Bul(sc) S by F Aeg, F Eas-Ion, F Ion-Nap /a//Apu,Adr/, A Bul-Rum, A Run-Ukr S by A Sev, A Bud S GERMAN A Tri-Vie. Ows: Ank, Con, Smy, Sev, Rum, Bud, Sev, Bul, ~~Gre~~ (8). Remove 1.

WINTER 1913 ADJUSTMENTS are due Wednesday, 20 May 1970. Players may, of course, make adjustments conditional upon the direction of the Turkish retreat.

AUSTRIA SURGES TOWARD VICTORY

Fall 1908/Winter 1908:

AUSTRIA (Naus): A Ven-Rom S by A Tus, F Tun H, A Pru-Ber, A Mos H, A Sil-Mun S by A Boh, A Tri-Apu C by F Adr, A Sev H, F Smy H, A Con-Ank. Ows: Bud, Tri, Vie, Ven, Fom, Bul, Gre, Ser, Con, Sev, Mos, War, Rom, Tun, Ank, Smy (16). B A Tri, A Bud, A Vie (no room for 4th).

ENGLAND (Birsan): F Bre MS F Eng, F Mid-Por, F StP(sc) H S by F Nwy, A Bel-Bar S by A Ruh, A Kie & A Ber S GERMAN A Mun, F Bal S A Ber, A Hol-Bel S by F Nth. Ows: Edi, Lpl, Lon, Bel, Hol, Kie, Ber, Nwy, Swe, StP, Den, Bre (12). No change.

FRANCE (Peery): A Bur S AUSTRIAN A Sil-Mun, F Spa(sc)-Por, F Tyr-Wes, A Gas & A Pic S A Bur. Owns: Mar, Par, Por, Spa, ~~Wyn~~ (4). Remove A Pic.

GERMANY (civ.dis.): A Mun /h/. Owns: Mun (1). No change.

ITALY (civ.dis.): F Nap /h/, A Rom /h/ /a/. Owns: Nap, ~~Wyn~~ (1). No change (1 /a/).

TURKEY (civ.dis.): A Arm /h/. Owns: ~~Wyn~~, ~~Wyn~~ (0). OUT. GM E A Arm.

Note: It appears fairly obvious at this point that Austria should be able to win without much trouble. He can get Naples in 1909, plus probably Marseilles or Munich or both. France has stated he does not intend to stop Austrian incursions (see the press release below), and is willing to concede to Austria now. Edi, do you wish to concede, or play on? Please let me know, by the deadline below. Other players should submit Spring moves in case the English player does not concede to Austria.
