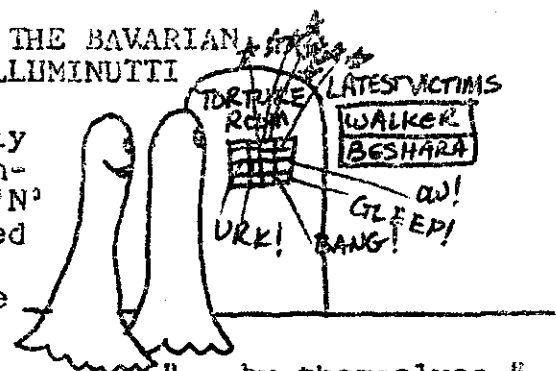


# WILE 'N' WORRY #20 -- 12 May 1971

FRANCE (Wells): No change, W19. A Pie-Tyr S by A Ven & A Tri, A Bur-Mun, A Pic-Bur S by A Par, F Alb & F Adr S A Tri, F Mar-Pie.

GERMANY (Naus): No change, W 19. F Nth-Eng, A Ruh-Bur S by A Bel, A Kie-Ruh, A Tyr H S by A Vie & A Mun (A Mun /d//Boh, ob/).

TURKEY (Koning)(vonMetzke): F Con-Bla, A Gre-Ser S by A Bul, A Arm-Sev; F Aeg S A Bul.
