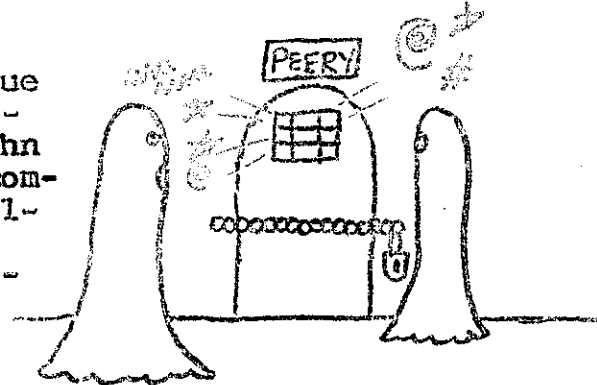


THE BAVARIAN ILLUMINUTTI

GASCHURN (IPT)(22 April 1902): Imperial Minister vonWarren is again running the War Ministry from a hillside hammock near the sleepy capital of the Independent and Anonymous County of Warrenstein. Each spring, as the trees begin to bud and the grass grows green again, Minister vonWarren moves the entire War Ministry into his castle near here and seems to spend most of his time during the days relaxing in the open air. This year he brought with him the entire imperial Third Army, newly raised during the winter, for final training exercises and various "war games". (cont. in 27).
