Fall 1913 revisited: Thanks to Hal Naus, we have uncovered a perfectly magnificent error (which you all probably caught, but Hal is closer). The moves should be changed as follows:

ENGLAND (McCallum): A Vie-Bud. Owns: Bud (11). Build 2. TURKEY (Koning): A Bud S GERMAN A Tri-Vie /d//Ser/. Owne: but (7). Remove 2. The deadline is unchanged, remaining at Wednesday, 20 May 1970.
