

THE FUR ELIES. Effective immediately: Rule 13a (added): A player may nominate his resignation in a game at any time. Game fees will not be refunded. Resigning players will be replaced as noted in Rule 13. However, no resignation will be accepted if it is not accompanied by a set of orders for the upcoming season in that game (unless such a set is already on file with GM GM). Players who resign without submitting orders will not be considered as resigned and will be continued in the game until that rule is complied with or until they are dropped under the provisions of Rule 13. * * * Rule 31 (revised): See the 1971 rulebook Rule XII.4. A player may specify the Fleets which are to convoy his army, if he wishes. If he does, the convoy route specified will be the only valid one. He must write his order in this way: "ENGLAND" (sic) 100% F Eng C & Con-Belt. This procedure will be useful in confused situations, such as: ENGLAND (as above), GERMANY: F ENG C & CON-BELT, A LOND-100%. THESLA: F ROME-Nich 3 My F Eng. Without this rule, the English convoy would fail under the terms of XII.4.

SPRING 1902 ANALYSIS -- Len Lakefka. What an interesting war! Italy and Austria decide to square each other up. Turkey pushes on the west, Russian south. England and German team up on Russia?

Well, let's try to pull something out of the chaff. I had said Germany was about to be served up because of the directions of his neighbors. Yet it now appears that France has stabbed England brutally and switched his alliance to the strange land power. Why did he do this? Russia and England have tried each other down in a futile northern campaign. Germany seems to know, as does France. Thus, Italy will continue versus Austria, regardless of how unlikely the attempt is. So France played the logical strong shift to cripple England before he can recover, and later to destroy whoever wins in the Italian-Austrian death struggle. The German-French alliance will be a tough nut to crack. Only sane action by Turkey and Austria can offset it.

Let's look at the tactical Spring move. England played the bounce move to StP., knowing Germany would attack Sweden--very good. But--can England really ally with France and Germany and did the move to the Channel and Nth come as a surprise? It should not have. F Pre, F Por, & F Mar--where would these likely go? If Germany was to aid England, then F Ele should have made England cautious. Yet he struck into Russia with full vigor. Too bad he won't enjoy the victory after F Mid-Iri, F Spal(sc)-Mid, A Pic-Lon C by F Eng!

Germany has played a bold decisive move. He knew his flanks were safe and moved almost with abandon. Yet his aggression looks as if it will pay off, with both Non and Sve added to the German tally.

Italy has made another weak and un inventive move. F Ion-Adr was the logical move and suited for by the tactical situation. Now he is doomed as the Austrian steamship let takes Naples for free.

Russia has lost the south, too--poor soul. Turkey now stoops for Rumania with obvious misgivings. A Vic-tri, A Mid-Iri S by F Adr, F Ion-Nap, A Bul-Bukum (S by AUSTRIAN A Ser) S by F Bla, A Arm-Sev, F Con-Bul(ec).

The losers--England, Russia, & Italy--can do little to avoid total collapse this year. Russia has cast the die and England has foolishly bent over to pick it up. If any of these powers hope for survival they must offer to bid one or more of the A's gone to become super-Powers. But German-French and Austrian-Austrian alliances have done their homework well and their unions are very strong and durable.

PADRID (15 July 1962) (UPI Press): Alfonso XIII de Bourbon was crowned today. News analysts had predicted this development as a result of Spanish churchmen and monarchists gaining the support of the French clergy. Cardinal Ciudad of Faro officiated the coronation. King Mancel II de Leon of Portugal welcomed restoration of Spain's monarchy, adding, "A nation must look to its symbol of state and strength for it to remain strong."

PALMA (17 July 1962) (UPI Press): Princess Lucrecia deBarja today broke her long self-imposed silence to hold a news conference. Her Highness was exiled from the Principality of the Balearic Islands by the Carter of the former Spanish Republic because of her successful attempt to seduce the entire Ministry as part of a plot to make herself Queen. "She neglected us!" declared the Carter in voting to exile Princess Lucrecia.

Her Highness held her assembled newsmen, "It is obvious that I am the rightful Queen of Spain. And I am going to prove it!" Two hours later, when panting reporter finally admitted that the Princess was the rightful Queen, Her Highness declared that she would soon launch an invasion of Spain to reclaim her throne.

VALENCIA (18 August 1962) (UPI Press): Doctor Ricardo Villanueva prepared to do battle. He had been appointed Commander-in-Chief of Princess Lucrecia's Liberation Army last month, and 5 days ago had landed at Valencia. His forces had been ordered to seize control of the town, including the Civil Guard barracks, and to capture the entire people of Valencia. They had done so, but the Count, the white owl who was God's drunk, those who had been captured had a choice.

"I am a soldier," said the Count, "I am a soldier." In the front ranks stood his soldiers, the backbone of his army. Most of them were old men, leaning down their rifles toward the sky as they said, "We are here to defend our country and our families, and we are here to defend our Queen." And the Count, who was very fond of fierce challenges, half of whom slept and the other half cleaning out their ears with their bayonets. "They should remove them from their rifles, first," thought the Count. Near-by was a contingent of fearsome Zagrzlopp tribesmen from the Balkans, astride
