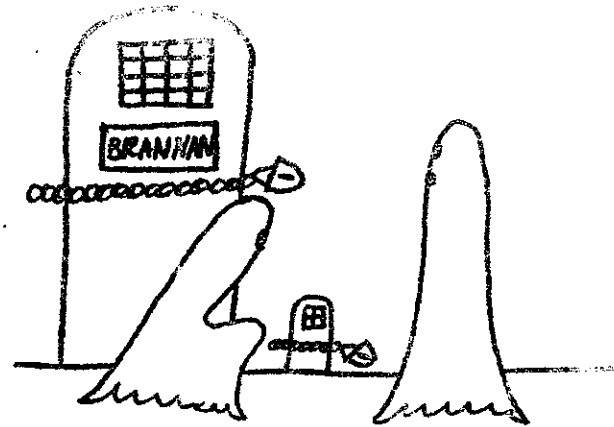

Winter 1913: In addition to the other errors pointed out in #3, I forgot to re-compute supply center holdings. England, while gaining Bud, failed to hang onto Vie, so that England had only one build, and Germany had two. Supply center counts for this game were: E, 10; F, 9; G, 8; T, 7. OK?

John Peery failed to submit Autumn retreats or Winter removals. Conrad von Metzke, his stand-by for this game, did so for John. If John misses Spring 1914 moves, he will be replaced by Conrad.

ENGLAND (Morgan): B A Ed. FRANCE (Wells): E A Par. GERMANY (Naus): B A Bud, A Mos. SWITZER (Koenig, 2, by vi): F Ion (R)-/a/, A Bud (R)-/a/.

MOVES are due Friday, 5 June 1970. HOWEVER—a postal strike is again in effect in Canada, and may even have begun. If so, the deadline above is cancelled. The deadline is reset to a date 21 days after the resumption of mail service to Canada (or at least into and out of Ralston).
