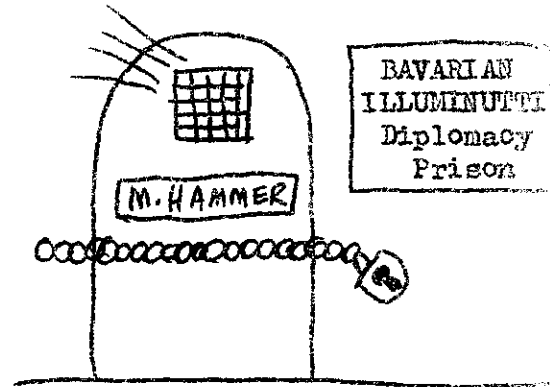

RUSSIA (Naus): A Sev S A Mos, A Ukr-War S by A Mos, F Rum-Bla, A Mun-Boh, A Bol-Vie S by A Tyr.

TURKEY (vonMetzke): F Ank-Bla, A Con-Bul, A Bul-Ser, F Tyr-Ion, F Ion-Adr, F Tus-Rom, F Pie-Tus, A Ven-Tri, A Apu-Ven.

FALL 1911 MOVES are due Thursday, 17 September 1970, and may be made conditional upon the direction of the English retreat. Error: In addition to Pru and Sil, the dislodged English A War may also retreat to Gal.
