





DAVE CARTER AWARD NOMINATIONS

The first nomination is from Dave Carter, namesake for the award and publisher of the excellent 'zine Sleepless Knights: | "For my namesake award, I nominate Bob Acheson. Bob is not public about his male chauvanistic attitudes, but he rates a 10 from me based on private conversations. Anyway, we've had a Canuck and a Yank, so why not an iceman (Bob lives in Northwest Territories)"

((Dave, I trust your judgement, but I have nothing else to go on. How does he rate on the other things he does in private? I'll have to keep my eye on Bob for future awards, but compared to the other nominations, I cannot justify giving him the award...this year.))

Here is a nomination from last year's winner, Steve "I'll do anything to win" Hutton who publishes No Fixed Address, another of my favorite 'zines - the last issue of which was spiral bound and 124 pages!!: "As most of you know, the Dave Carter Award was established two years ago to honour the most sexist person in the postal Diplomacy hobby. Almost alone among hobby services, the DCA has a completely clean name, unsullied by boycotts or allegations of impropriety. As incumbent, I have a strong interest in maintaining the award's good name. Ten years from now, I want to say with pride that I once won the Dave Carter Award. I want my name to be in the company of men and women whose sexism is unquestionable, not every Tom, Dick, and Harry who drools over brassiere ads.

Because of my strong concern for the integrity of this award, I have spent the last year searching for a suitable successor. No slur against women, however slight, has escaped my attention. After this exhaustive search, I have come to the conclusion that one hobbyist stands head and shoulders above the rest in sexism. I refer, of course, to Steve Hutton.

Now, this may come as a surprise to some of you. After all, Dave Carter himself has said that I don't have much of a chance given my new ...er... reputation. But is this really the case? I $\underline{\text{will}}$ acknowledge that it's now more difficult to convince the hobby that I view women as sex objects; on the other hand, this can only bolster my credentials as a woman-hater.

Well, we've had a Yank, A Canuck and now a Limey. Who knows what next year will bring?


HERE ARE SOME MORE NOMINATIONS FOR THE DAVE CARTER AWARD
