ROME (15 July 1907): Pope Cynthia has declared that this year she will visit the Holy Land. No reason was given for the trip, but there is a rumor

that a certain Swede of great reputation will be there soon. Her Holiness has been overheard saying, "Such a big, handsome man would make a perfect Father Confessor. Who could withhold ANYTHING from a man so well equipped to administer penance? Sigh...."

NUEVA ROMA (17 July 1967): Her Holiness Joan III today addressed an encyclical to Pope Cynthia: "Why-for you horny in on-a my act?"
